Simply put – we know that trained leaders deliver a better program.

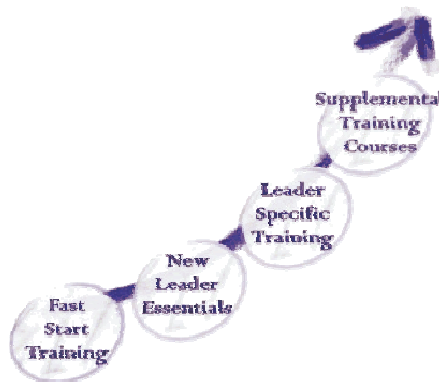
It has been shown that:
